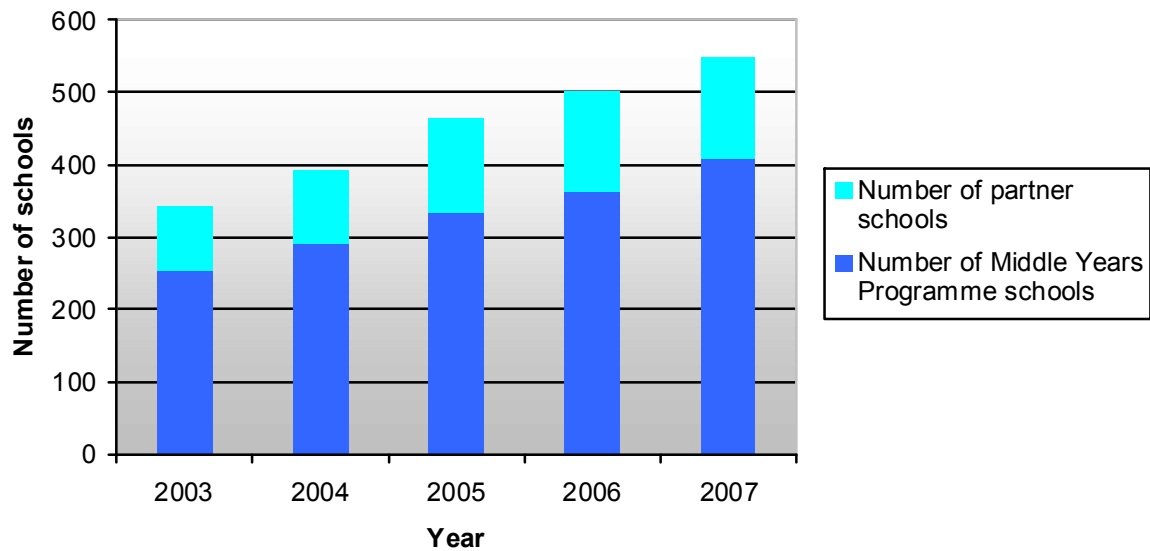

**Graph 1.1** Number of schools following the Middle Years Programme 2003–2007

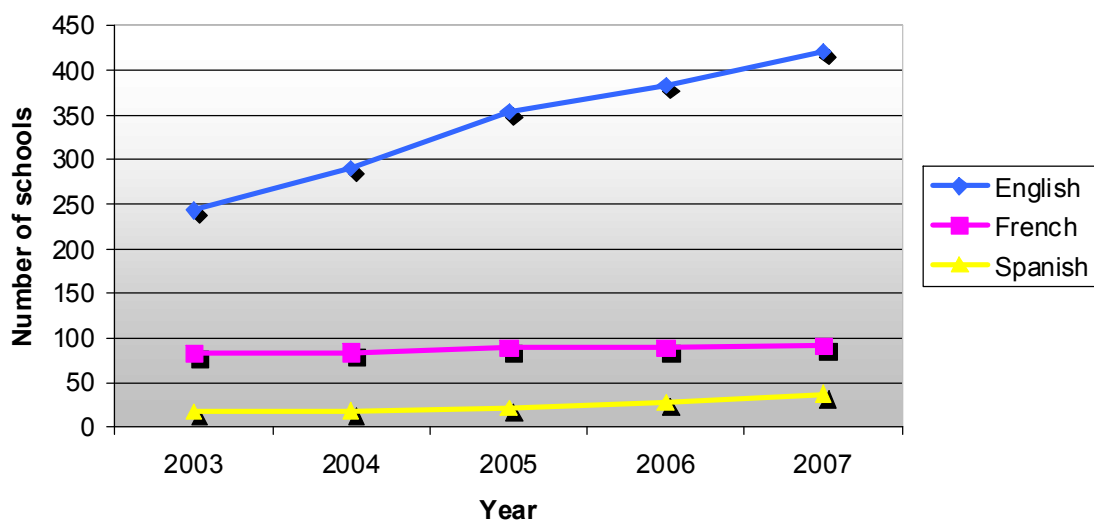

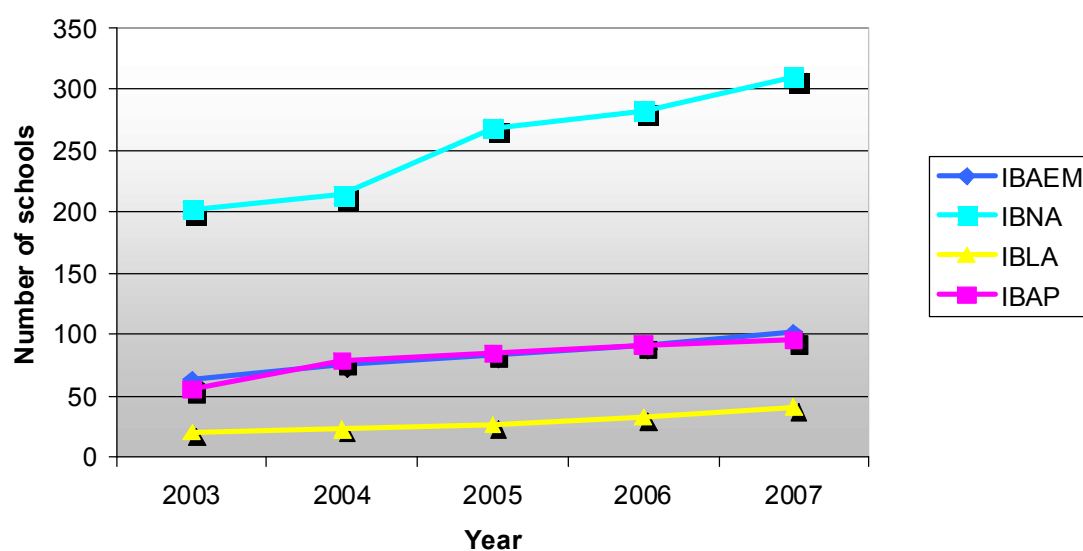

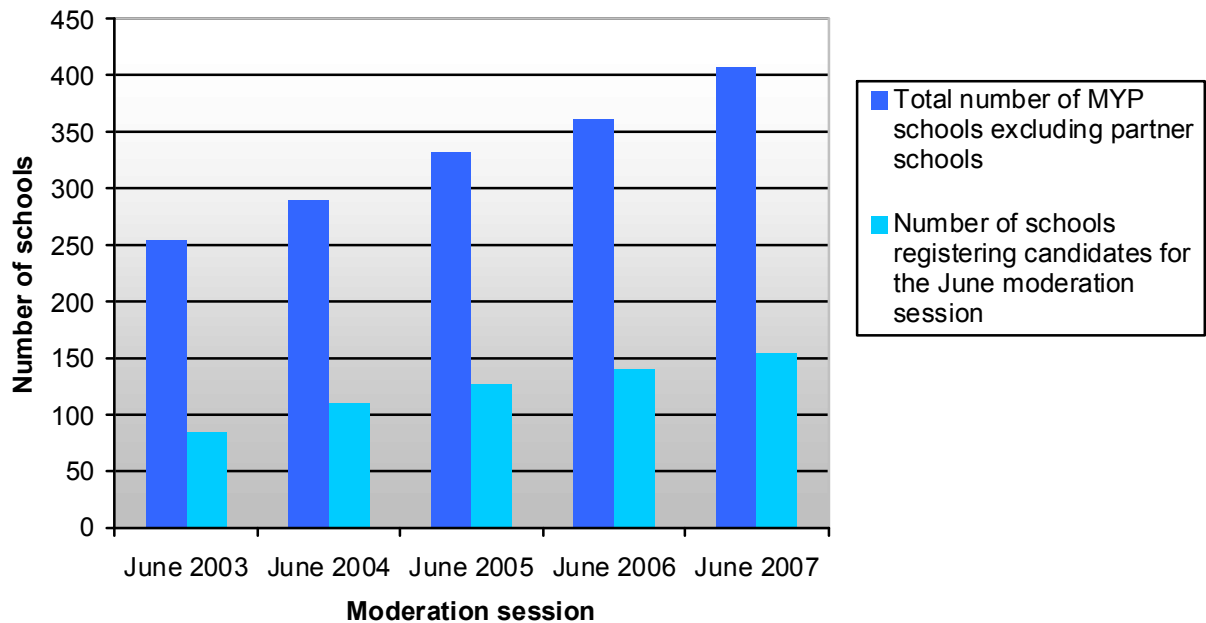

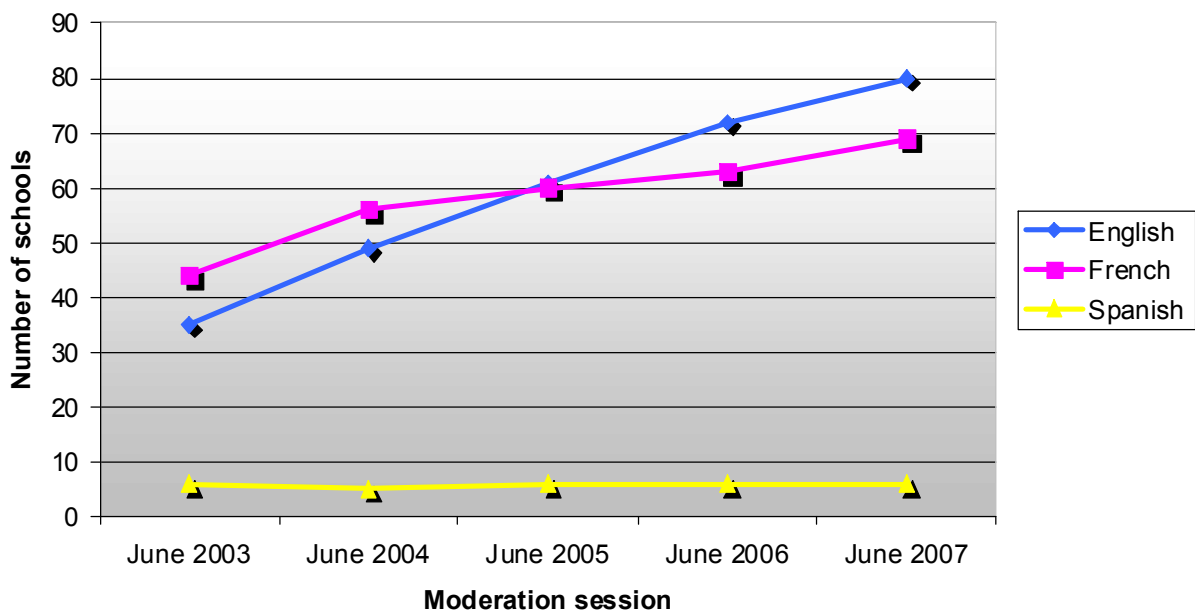
**Graph 4.1** Number of schools registering candidates for moderation June 2003–June 2007

Graph 5.1 Number of schools registering candidates by working language June 2003–June 2007

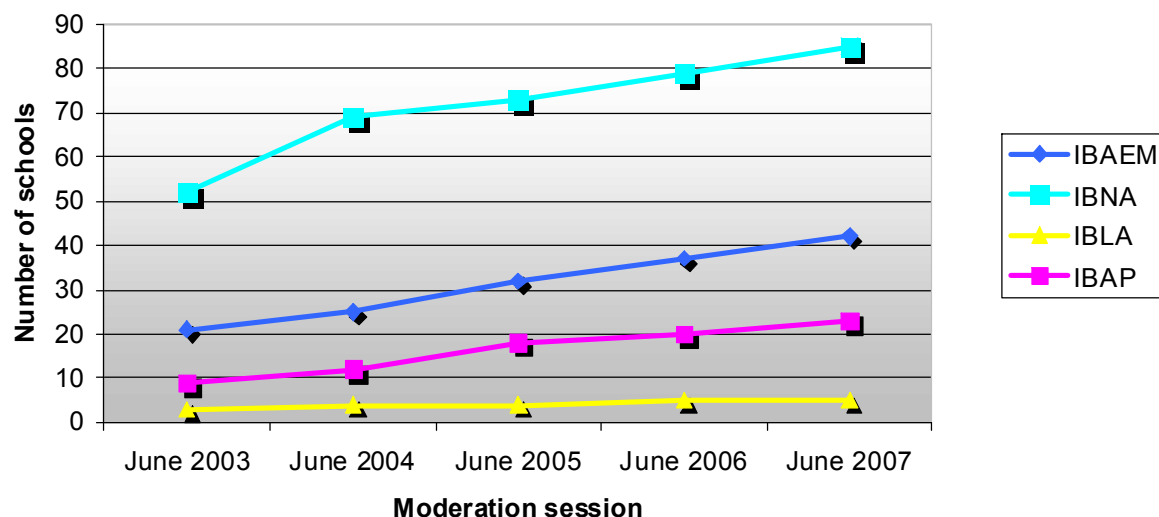

Graph 6.1 Number of schools registering candidates by IB region June 2003–June 2007



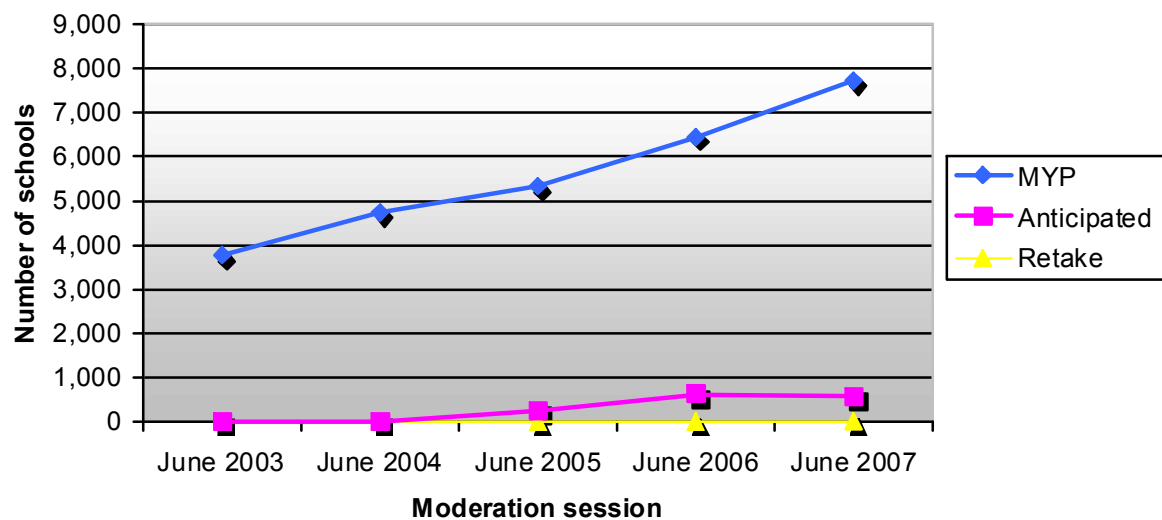

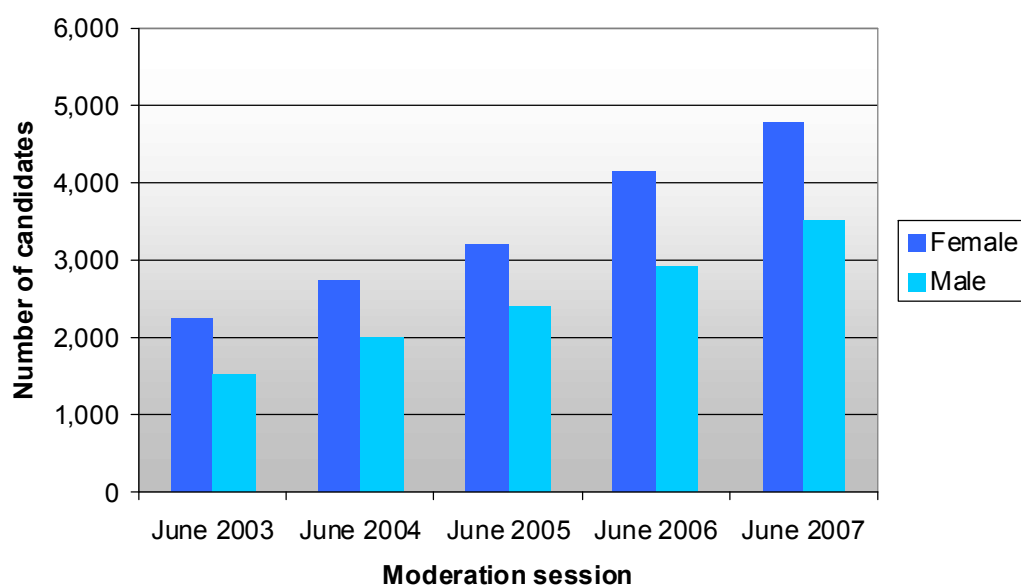
Graph 7.1 Number of candidates registered by category June 2003–June 2007

Graph 8.1 Number of candidates registered by gender June 2003–June 2007

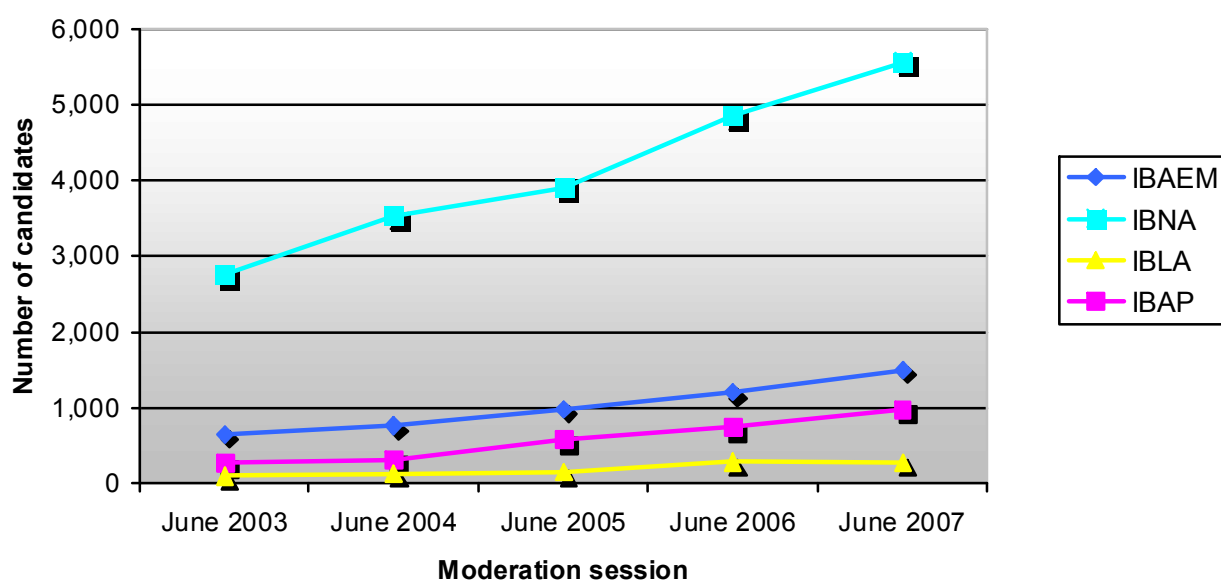

Graph 9.1 Number of candidates registered by IB region June 2003–June 2007

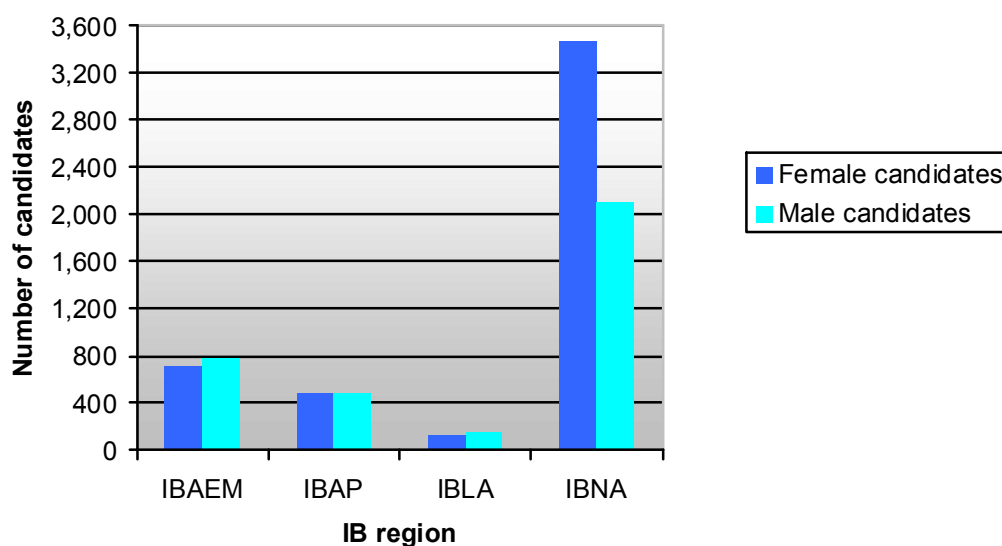

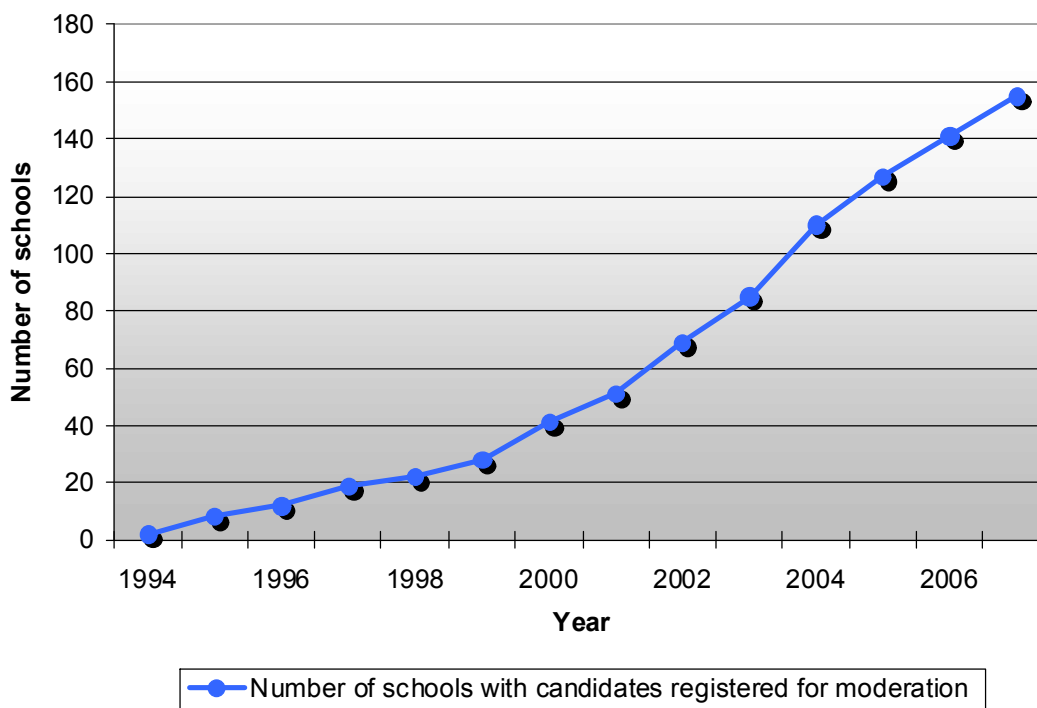
Graph 10.1 Number of candidates registered by gender and IB region June 2007

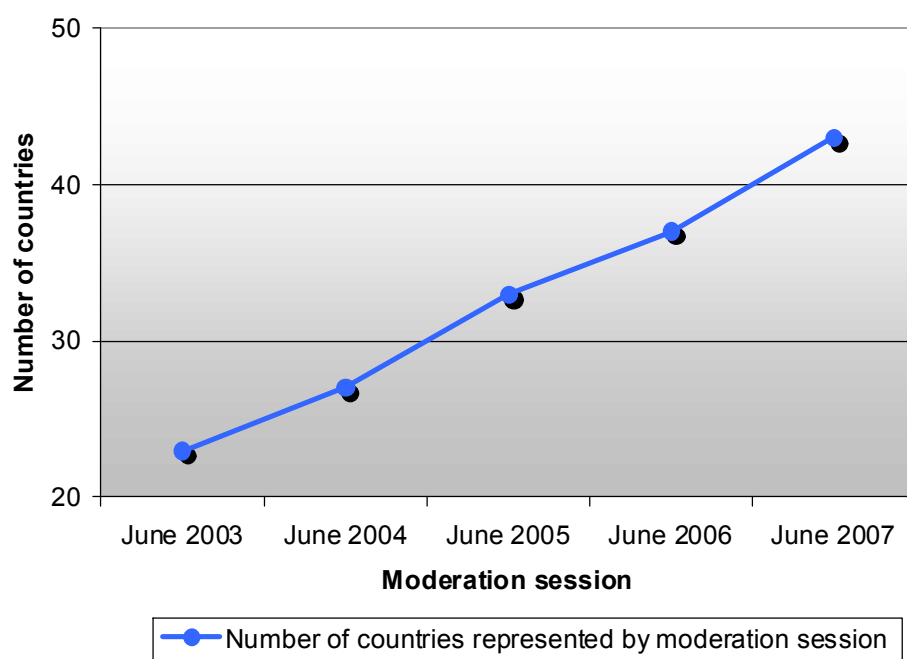
